TEAM UP TO DREAM UP!

Two Philanthropic websites partner up to help kids make a difference in the world

Daisy Button Believes™, a new networking site for kids ages 8-12, recently teamed up with Little Loving Hands™ to encourage more kids to do good and give back to make a difference in the world.



DaisyButtonBelieves.com launched in February and is a FREE social networking service where kids focused on philanthropy can access resources, funding and like-minded friends. Kids create an account and can post and share about struggles and triumphs, research topics for their charity, ask questions to kids who have already been successful and to business experts. They can also apply for a monthly funding grant of \$1,000.



Little Loving Hands™ enables children to learn about the importance of empathy and charitable giving through crafts. They offer a subscription service where a different charity is spotlighted each month and kids receive all the materials and instructions to create a craft that is sent back to the organization to be handed out to those in need. Each kit also includes items and information to reinforce who, how, and why they are helping. Little Loving Hands also offers single kits for purchase including one that allows a child to create crafts to fundraise for a charity of their choice.

Both sites are privately funded and seek to give kids a place to go when they are seeking help with their projects, ideas, dreams and plans to do something big to help others.

The founder of Little Loving Hands™, Lily Yeh is a mother of two girls and created Little Loving Hands as a result of her search for activities to engage her children in charitable giving with hands on involvement. As a result of her children's age, she found limited opportunities, but Lily was determined to figure out a solution to stress the importance of empathy to her daughters early and quickly found that many other parents and caretakers wanted to do the same. "Little Loving Hands is a unique offering that provides the activities and tools to help raise awareness and make kids feel empowered and encouraged to make an impact on the lives of others that need support. It provides parents, grandparents, aunts, and others with children in their lives to have valuable learning experience to raise kind kids. It is amazing when we can show that the littlest people have the biggest hearts in a world that sometimes seems a bit intimidating." Yeh said. One of Lily's favorite quotes that sums up Little Loving Hands is the following by L.R. Knost "It's not our job to toughen our children up to face a cruel and heartless world. It's our job to raise children who will make the world a little less cruel and heartless."

Tracey Serebin, a children's author, is the founder of Daisy Button Believes. She created the site after her own experience working with kids for over 10 years, providing tools for success. She has written a series of entrepreneurial books called Daisy Button Adventures and then developed a comprehensive on-line curriculum for 4th to 6th graders that

accompanied it. Her program was picked up by 5 schools in New Jersey. After going through a personal crisis recently, Tracey decided the time was now for her to make a difference. She wanted to get the tools she created into the hands of kids directly. By creating daisybuttonbelieves.com kids could easily interact with other kids around the country that were also helping others and creating an impact in their community. *"I realized there was no central location that kids could learn from each other, find the resources they needed to take their ideas and dreams to the next level, and get feedback from other kids who had succeeded in a big way. I also wanted to expose them to adult role models that have created successful platforms and used their money and position for good."* Serebin said.

Working together with Little Loving Hands, Serebin believes she will be able to attract kids at any stage in their idea and keep them motivated so their dreams can come true, their ideas can be executed on and the world around them can be a kinder, more positive place for them to live in. *"Anything is possible. We are going to prove that!"* Serebin promises.
